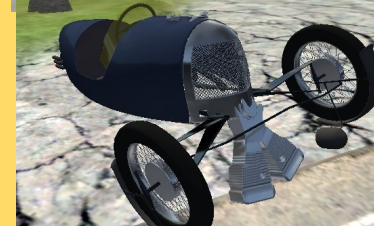

Civetta Bolide

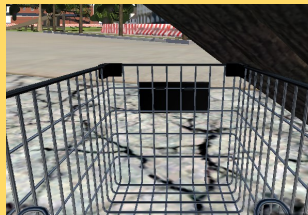


Trolley driver: Rowan Atkinson (Mr bean) IQ 185
